



If a Storm Leaves You Without Power...

Treat wires and power lines as if they are energized and deadly. Stay far from downed power lines and anything in contact with fallen lines. If you see a downed or snapped line, keep everyone away and call us immediately at (800) 465-1212.

Notify us by phone at (800) 465-1212. Do not assume that someone else has called to report an outage on your street.

Report your outage and find restoration updates online at Liberty Utilities' Outage Central site at libertyutilities.com/east/electricity/outage_central/index.html.

If you have a generator, use it outdoors only. Never use a generator inside any enclosed areas, not even a garage. The exhaust fumes contain poisonous carbon monoxide and can kill or cause serious injury.

If you depend on life support equipment, call us today at (800) 375-7413 to begin the short process of having it noted on your account.

Check with the NH Region Red Cross to find out where the nearest shelter and aid will be available if needed at nhredcross.org.

Fully charge your mobile phones and place the car charger in your glove compartment.

Prepare an emergency kit with items including: bottled water; non-perishable food and can opener; battery-powered or hand crank radio; flashlight and extra batteries; a first aid kit.

Turn your refrigerator and freezer to their coldest settings ahead of a storm to keep food fresh longer in the event of a power outage.
