Dartmouth-Hitchcock Nashua qualified for over \$245,000 in incentives for energy efficiency measures implemented in the construction of their new facility.

In January of 2012, Dartmouth-Hitchcock Nashua opened a new medical office building combining the services offered at three existing locations in Nashua under one roof.
