5. *Build homes consistent with ENERGY STAR Recommendation Report and Coordinate on Site Visits*
6. *Receive ENERGY STAR Certification, Rebates and Technical Support*

Eligibility Requirements

- Builder must submit an approved ENERGY STAR Application to their local utility
- Builder agrees to update program application with any changes to the project or construction schedule
- Builder agrees to coordinate inspections with assigned ENERGY STAR contractor
- Homes must meet ENERGY STAR program standards to qualify for label and financial incentives
- Homes must be separately electrically metered, new residential construction or a complete building rehab as defined by ENERGY STAR. Gas homes may be multi-metered if they are 3 stories or less.
- Homes can be single-family, multi-family or townhouse style construction three stories or less in height, or four stories where each residential unit has its own heating, cooling, and hot water systems, separate from other units. Homes may be five stories if they are located on top of commercial spaces so long as the entire structure is five stories or less, and each unit has its own heating, cooling, and hot water systems separate from other units
- Windows must be ENERGY STAR rated or better
- At least (one) ENERGY STAR bath fan operated by programmable timer is required
- Electrical service must be provided by an electric utility sponsor
- Construction of the home must be “completed” by December 31, 2015 to receive financial incentives unless the sponsoring utility has approved a rebate extension
