Regional Greenhouse Gas Initiative

The Regional Greenhouse Gas Initiative (RGGI) is the first mandatory, market-based CO2 emissions reduction program in the United States. Carbon allowances are auctioned periodically, and the revenue we receive goes back to our customers in the form of a credit under transmission rates. **For the 2024-2025 period, which runs from May 1, 2024 - April 30, 2025, we will be giving \$3,386,107 back to our electric customers.** This money is distributed on a per kWh basis.
