

Important Message for our Customers Regarding Electric Rates

On April 29th, 2016 Liberty Utilities (Granite State Electric) Corp. submitted a request to the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission (“PUC”) to raise the rates we charge for distribution of electric service.

If the PUC approves our request as submitted, the total bill for a residential customer using 650 kWh of electricity per month will increase from \$123.62 to \$133.65 (8.11%). This increase is in comparison to the rates in effect at the time of the filing. For the impact on all rate classes, see the reverse of this notice.

The PUC will conduct a comprehensive review of our request and the final decision may take up to a year to be rendered.
