What's On My Gas Meter?



Meter Bar Holds and supports the

meter.

Regulator

Controls the amount of natural gas that goes into your property.

Service Riser

Connects the gas piping to your meter.

Tracer Wire

A safety feature that is installed next to underground piping and helps us locate the path of a plastic pipe. This wire will either be yellow or white.

Please note that while this is the most common meter setup, not all meters at all locations will have the parts shown above. Meter setup varies case by case.

Keeping Your Meter Clear

Your gas meter needs to be kept clear so we can access it in an emergency. Please verify that all vegetation is a minimum of 36" away from your natural gas meter. If you need to dig to remove vegetation, **please call 811 before you begin. It's free and it's the law.** This also applies in winter as well. Keep your meter free of snow and ice using a broom or hand brush and maintain access to the meter.

Play it Safe - With Carbon Monoxide

Carbon Monoxide is created by the incomplete combustion of fuel, including wood, propane, natural gas or oil. It is a colorless and odorless substance that can cause illness and death.

Symptoms of exposure include headaches, nausea, dizziness, coughing, ringing in the ears and spots before the eyes. If you suspect exposure, get to fresh air and call 911 right away. Protect yourself by installing Carbon Monoxide detectors in your home.

Be Smart When Using a Third Party to Pay Your Bill.

Some of our customers use 3rd party bill payment agencies to pay their utility bills in person or online. Not all payment agencies are authorized to collect payments on our behalf. We cannot guarantee that your payment will be applied to your account correctly if you use an unauthorized payment agency. Be cautious. Most importantly, always keep your receipt.

Natural Gas is Coming to Pelham!



The NH Public Utilities Commission and Town Officials in Pelham have granted Liberty Utilities franchise rights to serve Pelham with natural gas. As of August 10, 2017, construction to bring natural gas into Pelham is officially underway.

The initial build-out is occurring in the town center and is expected to be completed by the end of 2017.

Pelham will be Liberty Utilities' first service area that provides customers with both electric and gas services exclusively.
