- A rebate of 100% of the installed cost of air sealing in your home and 75% of the installed cost of insulation (up to \$6,000)
- 2% financing through select local financial institutions
- 0% on-bill financing available through Liberty
- Eligible to receive other energy saving measures

Tax Credits Available for Home Improvement

Good news for NH residents! The IRS reinstituted and increased the **Energy-Efficient Home Improvement Credit**, which allows households to credit up to 30% of the cost of energy efficiency home upgrades against their taxes. This credit can total up to \$1,200 per year for weatherization work completed at your home. The full credit is available for home improvements made starting in 2023.
